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

Demolition of existing partial road/ramp, Bulk excavation of an ex-quarry site with up to 4 levels of basement, including CFA secant shoring piles & soldiers (3.9km of drilling), D&C of foundation piles (6.8km of drilling), capping beam, shotcrete, anchoring, detail excavation & soil remediation of contaminated materials up to 55000t to be removed.



Piety THP

Wentworth Point

\$12,985,201.09

Demolition of 18000 squares of factory space. Excavating down 6 levels of basement totaling 146000 cubic meters of bulk excavation to be removed. This included removal of contaminated materials such as Potential acid sulphate soils and Gsw-r materials. Averaging 8000t of excavated material being carted away per day allowed the project to finish way ahead of schedule.

Plant & Equipment

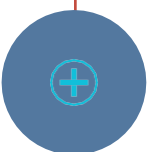
ADN has a large fleet of plant equipment and trucks used throughout a project's life span. Maintaining the machinery is key to keeping the site and employees safe as well as ensuring a quality execution.

Plant



With over 30 excavators, ranging from as little as 1.5 tonne to 50 tonne ADN can manage any site with ease regardless of size. ADN owns its own water cart, street sweeper & possi-track as well as numerous hydraulic/non-hydraulic attachments including a long reach attachment. ADN also possesses several rigs ranging from 20-75 tonne, which all have the capability to drill in collapsing ground using the continuous flight augur method (CFA).

Trucks



Starting from as little as 2 tonne to as large as 57 tonne (PBS quad-dogs), ADN has various trucks which are crucial to hauling soil or general demolition waste to tipping facilities around Sydney. By maintaining a sound professional relationship with tipping facilities, ADN has very good access to many tips around Sydney. ADN also possesses an EPA protection licences (EPL) to haul contaminated trackable waste.
